Regular Board Meeting of June 7, 2016

- After winning gold medals at the <u>Greater Vancouver Regional Science Fair last</u> <u>month</u>, three SD43 students competed at the <u>Canada-Wide Science Festival (CWSF)</u> on May 14 in Montreal. All three students won top prize in their respective categories and a combined \$17,500 in special awards and scholarships!
 - Kelvin Zhang, Grade 10, Gleneagle Secondary: Gold Medal (Intermediate Excellence Award)
 - Janice Pang, Grade 12, Pinetree Secondary: Silver Medal (Senior Excellence Award)
 - Vladislav Pomogaev, Grade 12, Riverside Secondary: Bronze Medal (Senior Excellence Award).

While recently in China to expand and promote SD43's International Education partnerships, **Superintendent Patricia Gartland gave a lecture on inquiry-based learning** to an audience of approximately 150 principals and dignitaries in Pinggu, a suburb of Beijing, at the **2016 Beijing International Education Exchange (BIEE) Seminar.**
- 3. On May 12, the Coquitlam Public Library in partnership with SD43, the City of Coquitlam, and Douglas College, hosted a Science Expo open to Coquitlam students from grades 3-12. Students from 17 schools participated in the event in four categories based on grade level: elementary, middle, junior and senior. The following winners received a trophy and a cash prize:
 - Elementary 1st place: Sound Booth by Chelsey Whitmore (Nestor Elementary)
 - Middle 1st place: The Future of Climate Change and its Effect on Plants by Kristin Lo & Violet Beech (Maple Creek Middle)
 - Junior 1st place: Analysis of Sleep by Mike Roslikov (Inquiry Hub Secondary)
 - Senior 1st place: Improvised Semiconductors by Raymond Shi & Jake Moersch (Port Moody Secondary)
- Out of 10,000 students from across British Columbia, 260 total and 9 from School
 District 43 (Coquitlam) were selected to compete in the Provincial finals for the
 33rd Annual French public speaking competition, Concours d'art oratoire, on May 7
 at Simon Fraser University (Surrey).





- 5. **Terry Fox Secondary student, Jack Thomas received the Tri City R.E.A.C.H. award** for a youth overcoming adversity, as a one-armed drummer.
- 6. **SD43** students raised \$11,000 for the Red Cross to help the Fort McMurray Fire Victims. After being matched by the government this equals \$22,000 in funds!
- 7. **SD43** Real Acts of Caring received the official BC Government Proclamation of RAC week from MLA Linda Reimer on May 27 at Maple Creek Middle.






