News from the January 10, 2012 School Board Meeting

DISTRICT STAFF REPORTS

Superintendent Tom Grant reflected on the outstanding philanthropic initiatives by students and staff that led up to the Christmas season; registrations are underway for various programs of choice; he outlined the day's visits by Minister of Education George Abbot; and January 11 is the second annual Community Networking Day.

NEW BUSINESS

The Board of Education adopted Policy 1 - Learning Without Boundaries. Formulated through a collaborative process, the revised policy represents a pared-down version of its predecessor, which better aligns with the district vision.

The International Education Program has been successful in its application for a reclassification of the Confucius Classroom in SD 43 to the Confucius Institute in Coquitlam, as approved by the Chinese Language Council International (Hanban) in Beijing, China in December 2011. This sets the stage for the district to play a leadership role in province-wide initiatives that strengthen educational cooperation between China and Canada.
