News from the September 13, 2011 School Board Meeting

DELEGATIONS/PRESENTATIONS

Representatives from the Tzu-Chi Foundation presented a cheque to the Board for \$12,000 to assist vulnerable children attend summer camps and recreational activities. The Board reciprocated with a certificate of appreciation and hand-crafted thank-you cards from children who previously attended camp. The Tzu-Chi Foundation has provided bursaries to SD43 for a number of years to assist vulnerable children.

October 5 is World Teachers' Day, as declared by UNESCO and proclaimed by the Board of Education. This year's theme is "Teachers for Gender Equality". The Coquitlam Teachers' Association invited trustees and staff to join them for a barbecue at the CTA office site.

Principal Perry Muxworthy, Chair of the United Way Campaign, sought the Board's support in proclaiming October 18-26 as the 2011-2012 United Way Campaign. Last year, district employees donated just under \$45,000.

NEW BUSINESS

Gary Holtz, Acting Secretary-Treasurer, provided a report on the Full Day Kindergarten modulars, building additions and student drop-off improvements.

He also elaborated on a playground announcement from the Ministry, whereby four of our middle schools - Citadel, Como Lake, Kwayhquitlum and Maillard – will each receive \$50,000 from the Ministry in provincial funding for new playgrounds.

It will be eight weeks before the fire-damaged playground at Birchland will be replaced. The total cost of damage from the vandalism was over \$30,000. Director of International Education, Patricia Gartland, provided a presentation on the many activities of the International Ed division, including a very successful summer program.
