DELEGATIONS/PRESENTATIONS

NEW BUSINESS

The Board approved amendments to Policy16 – Recruitment and Selection of Personnel, reviewed a new AP – Recruitment and Selection of Principals and Vice-Principals, and the replacement of AP 140 – now the District-Wide Internet and Network Appropriate Use.

Superintendent Tom Grant and Assistant Secretary-Treasurer Chris Nicolls presented the 2012-13 Financial Outlook. For the first time in many years, the district is facing a significant budget shortfall of \$7.5 million. This is largely due to an enrolment decrease of more than 200 students, grant funding reductions resulting from reduced holdback funding, cost pressures and less than anticipated revenues. Several austerity measures have been put in place to recoup as much money as possible by June.
