As the third largest school district in B.C. and located in the Tri-Cities of Metro Vancouver, the school district has a population of 32,000 students with approximately 4,300 teaching, administrative, managerial and support staff.

This position reports to the Manager of Maintenance and under the coordination of the Trades Supervisor – Day Shift. This position is responsible for the work of the tradespersons, uncertified trades, contractors, and the security runners on the afternoon shift. A high level of independence and sound judgement will be required.

 - *Ability to communicate effectively, to establish and maintain effective relationships with employees, coworkers, supervisors, district and school administration, and contractors.*
