

Roles and Responsibilities

Teacher:

- Create student learning plans (in collaboration with parent and student) that reflect the needs of the student and meet the BC prescribed learning outcomes.
- Indicate instructional strategies, learning activities, and resources to support the individual student's learning plan.
- Provide consistent assessment (three formal report cards per year) to evaluate student progress and provide regular feedback.
- Provide expertise and support in understanding of curriculum content and learning outcomes.
- Facilitate enriched programs and access district services for students with individual education plans.
- Connect students to social situations (onsite: Vanier Centre(Encompass K – 9) where they have the opportunity to interact as a community of learners.

Parent:

- Collaborate with the teacher to develop and implement the student learning plan.
- Ensure that student work is submitted to the teacher on a regular basis for on-going assessment and feedback.
- Communicate regularly with the teacher through a variety of means: face to face meetings, phone calls, email, mail, etc.
- Provide an environment that encourages learning, where the parent is actively involved in facilitating learning that is indicated in the student learning plan.

Student:

- Ensure that assignments are completed to the best of his/her ability.
- Be involved with the planning stages of the student learning plan.
- Strive to be a motivated, active learner.
