## Outdoor Play Items

- Playground Expansion
- Accessible playground space ( > \$100,000 - or part of)
- Awnings for sun / rain cover ( $\sim \$ 5,000$ each)
- Benches for seating ( $\sim 3,000$ each)
- Buddy Bench


## Outdoor Learning spaces

- Outdoor mud kitchen ( $\sim 1,000$ )
- Outdoor classroom space (Depends on project / area chosen)
- Digging sandbox $(\sim \$ 5,000)$
- Gardening/raised beds (~\$750 each - This is a guess w/ Building, install and dirt)


## Technology

- Laptops (x 10 now) - (~\$4,000)
- Ipads ( $\sim 400$ each)
- Robots (Oz Bots) (Might be funded already)
- 10 Digital portable microscopes - (Order a sample - \$200 each)


## School Identity

- Hiring carver / artist for school identity project (\$10,000-\$20,000)
- Welcome Post
- Shield Carving
- Hiring Cultural Presentations (\$1,000-\$2000 / depending on scope)
- Ex, Sasquatch Dancers / Storytellers from Chehalis Nation
- Drums
- We would like a school set of drums (28) one idea was to have staff / Community members make them and then gift them to the school. (\$2,500-\$3,000)

We can also look at sponsoring any of the PAC events that they run. Sponsorship for school events would likely be best for things such as:

- Schooltime Sports Programs we run
- Lacrosse, Tennis, Hip Hop
- Cultural / Arts Performances
- These usually run \$800-\$1,200 / event
