- Hitler’s actions and policies

C4 evaluate ways in which Lenin and Stalin transformed the USSR, with reference to

- the Russian revolutions
- the Russian Civil War
- the New Economic Policy
- “socialism in one country”

C5 describe the relationship between colonial rule and emerging nationalism in Palestine and the Indian subcontinent

C6 describe social, economic, and political developments in the United States in the 1920s, including

- prohibition; the changing role of women
- urbanization, mass production, and consumerism
- isolationism and laissez-faire policies

- Arab nationalism
- Suez Crisis

E4 explain the role of nationalism in the post-1945 decolonization of India and Indochina

E5 explain key developments in the struggle for human rights in South Africa and the United States

***Progress and Uncertainty: 1963–1991***

F1 explain the significance of conflicts in Vietnam and the Middle East

F2 analyze changes in Chinese communism, with reference to

- the Cultural Revolution
- the changing relationship with the West
- Deng Xiaoping’s policies

F3 analyze the late stages of the Cold War with reference to

- the US/USSR relationship
- the decline of communism in Eastern Europe
- the dissolution of the Soviet Union
