<b>Hepatitis B</b> - available free for all infants -series of 3 doses starting at 2 months of age	●	●	●			
<b>Hepatitis A</b> - available free to Aboriginal infants or at Kindergarten entry - series of 2 doses			●		●	●
<b>MMR (Mumps/Measles/Rubella)</b> - available free for all infants -series of 2 doses starting on or after 1 <sup>st</sup> Birthday				●	●	
<b>Meningococcal C Conjugate</b> - available free for all infants -minimum of 1 Dose required on or after 1 <sup>st</sup> Birthday				●		
<b>Varicella (Chickenpox)</b> -available free for all infants -minimum of 2 doses after 1 <sup>st</sup> Birthday (not required if the child has had Chickenpox disease after age 1 yr.)				●		●
<b>Pneumococcal Conjugate</b> - available free for children all infants -minimum of 1 Dose required on or after 1 <sup>st</sup> Birthday				●		

**This immunization information is requested when your child:**

- is in kindergarten
- changes schools within B. C.
- enters university or college
- moves out of B.C. and immunization information required at new school
- is exposed to an outbreak of a preventable communicable disease
- travels to other countries
