We are proud to be one of the largest and most respected clubs in BC Minor Baseball. We maintain a strong emphasis on teaching the fundamental skills of the game, team play, good sportsmanship and building confidence and self esteem.

Through the hard work and dedication of many volunteers we strive to make this experience enjoyable and memorable for all, especially the players. The season runs from early April to mid June with some early training in the Mosquito and higher divisions. There are also summer All-star programs for Tadpole and higher divisions.



Our Association is comprised of the following divisions:

Rally Cap: (Born 2007) This is an entry level program designed to introduce 4 year old children to the game of baseball, keeping them active and engaged while learning the skills of the game in a fun, safe and informative atmosphere. The Rally Cap program creates an environment in which children and adults can both enjoy baseball. Games are on Thursday nights between 6:30 & 7:45pm. (Optional Saturday clinics will be available) **Fee \$ 80.00.**

Mini-Tadpole: (Born 2005 & 2006). Games are scheduled on Mondays & Wednesdays between 6:30 – 8:00pm. The division is split between Kindergarten & Grade 1 teams. Hitting is off a tee with adult pitching later in the season for Kindergarten teams and after a couple of weeks for Grade 1 teams. **Fee \$ 115.00.**

Tadpole: (Born 2003 & 2004). Tadpole games are scheduled on Tuesdays & Thursdays between 6:30 – 8:00pm. (Some possible daytime Saturday games) The division is split between Grade 2 & Grade 3 teams. Pitching is done by an adult or manual pitching machine at the beginning of the season. Players do some limited pitching later on for Grade 2 teams, with Grade 3 teams doing more pitching and starting earlier in the season. Regular practices are part of the program. **Fee \$ 125.00.**

Mosquito: (Born 2001 & 2002). This division introduces live player pitching and umpires calling balls and strikes. The Mosquito Division brings the Grade 4 and 5 players together with games scheduled Monday to Thursday from 6:00 - 8:00pm and daytime on Saturdays. All teams will be assigned weekend practice times to introduce the more advanced skills like base stealing and fielding techniques. Some teams will also attend regional tournaments throughout the season. **Fee \$ 160.00.**

PeeWee: (Born 1999 & 2000). This division includes a tiered A and AA program. All teams play interlocking games with other associations. We have fair playing-time rules for both tiers and a full roster batting order. The All-Star summer season begins after completion of the regular spring league and can provide opportunities to play through July and into August. Game schedules include weeknights and weekend games. **Fee \$ 170.00 .**

Bantam: (Born 1997 & 1998). This division is divided into 3 tiers: AAA, AA, and A. All teams play interlocking games with other associations. The AAA team's schedule is the most extensive running from April through mid-August. All-Star summer ball opportunity for A & AA players follows the regular season. **Fee \$ 200.00.** (AAA has additional fees TBD)

Midget: (Born 1994, 1995 & 1996). This division includes a tiered AA & AAA program. The AA level is run "in-house" while the AAA team is a joint effort with PCMBA (PoCo). The AAA team is competitive with games on Vancouver Island and the Interior. The season runs from April to August. The AA teams play from April to June in the Fraser Valley and then draft an All-Star team for the July/August season. **Fee \$ 235.00.** (AAA has additional fees TBD)
