Tubing Instructions

Read and complete the bottom of this form and return by fax or mail

Details to Note

- Tubing participants **MUST** be at least 122cm (48") tall to ride the tubes.
- There are no lockers or bag check at the Enquist Tube Park to store bags. Groups may leave bags in the Cedar Room on the lower level of the Enquist Lodge, but this area is not secure. **Leave valuables at home.**
- Snow tires are required on all vehicles and we recommend you carry chains. Please allow ample time to find parking, especially on weekends and holidays. Find the shuttle schedule at <http://mountseymour.com/gettinghere-shuttle>

Group Leader Instructions

- Make sure your group dresses appropriately for an alpine winter experience (waterproof jacket and pants, boots, toques, gloves).
- Unless Mt Seymour has closed, all programs proceed as scheduled, even in the rain or snow!
- Please review the Tubing Rules with your group **before arrival** (see below). Upon arrival, our staff will demonstrate proper safety. Plan to arrive at least 30 minutes before start time for ticketing and safety briefing.
- Group leader must remain with their group **at all times**.

Day of Activity

- Please call the Snow Phone (604-986-2261 option 1) before you depart, to check conditions.
- Day of activity only: If you are going to be arriving late, please contact Enquist staff at 604-986-2261 x261

Upon Arrival

- Group leader check in at the Enquist Lodge in P2 *please see map at <http://mountseymour.com/maps>
- Groups arriving by bus: Have group remain on the bus while the group leader checks in.
- If there is a line-up at the ticket window, politely proceed to the side and advise staff that you are checking in a group. Advise staff of any room bookings at this time.

Tubing Rules

1. Proceed only at the direction of attendant.
2. Walk to and start only at Start Gates. Wait for lane to clear before starting.
3. One person per tube/per lane.
4. Control your tube in a manner as to stay in your lane and be able to stop safely.
5. Do not bump or collide tubes. Respect the safety of others.
6. Keep both hands on the handles while sliding; lay down, face forward; drag feet to slow, steer and stop.
7. Stop before yellow crash bags. They are for emergencies only.
8. Clear out of your lane quickly and safely. Only staff is permitted in the run-out zone.
9. Only the lift operator is permitted to load/unload tubes.
10. Remain in tube if lift stops. You will receive instruction from lift operator. If tube becomes detached from lift, exit tube immediately.
11. No horseplay on the lift; secure all loose items; do not touch the cable.
12. Children under 122cm (48") tall, or anyone otherwise deemed unable to slide safely will not be able to use the tube park.
13. No ski boots allowed.
14. Small children must be supervised by someone 16 years or older.
15. No domestic animals permitted in the tubing area.
16. Impairment by drugs or alcohol will result in immediate removal with no refund.

Failure to observe the posted rules and the direction of attendants may result in accident and injury. Failure to observe posted rules and the direction of attendants will result in removal from the area and confiscation of pass with no refund.
