

PARENT/GUARDIAN FIELD TRIP CONSENT FORM

To Parents and Guardians:

School District #43 has recommended the use of the following standard consent form for all school field trips. The purpose of this letter is to inform you about a proposed optional field trip involving your child, and to seek your support and written permission for your child to participate.

Our planned field trip to Mount Seymour is intended to enhance the learning outcomes of the Advisory program. Attendance on the field trip is optional; therefore if you do not wish your child to participate in this activity, alternate learning experiences will be provided at the school. The cost of the field trip reflects your child's expenses only. No student will be denied access to a field trip or activity due to an inability to pay. Field Trip Information

Date of Field Trip: February 8, 2012

Nature of the Field Trip: This is a fantastic opportunity for the whole school community to participate in our Winter Club Day. Your son or daughter can learn a new winter sport at Mount Seymour and/or enjoy one or more pre-determined activities at a popular local destination. No previous experience is necessary, however, students are reminded to choose their activities wisely with their ability levels in mind. Ski and snowboard sessions include a mandatory 2 hour lesson (based on ability) taught by qualified instructors. The school code of conduct applies at all times; any dangerous, inappropriate or irresponsible behaviours exhibited while off school grounds will result in the student being returned to the school at the parent's expense.

Students will need to bring: Warm and layered clothing, waterproof pants and jacket, a toque, gloves, goggles, helmet (skiing/snowboarding) and extra socks. Students should also bring their own snacks, ample fluids, lunch or lunch money. On-mountain storage facilities are available for a nominal fee, but limited, so bring only what is necessary. Teachers will not supervise any belongings and are not responsible for items that are damaged, lost or stolen.

Arrive to school: 8:00 a.m. **Departure Time: 8:30 a.m.** **Anticipated Return Time: 4:00 p.m.**

Other Adult Supervisors: Teachers, parent volunteers and Mount Seymour instructors

Chaperones: Any parent that is interested in volunteering to help supervise students are not required to pay to be on the mountain but space is limited (first come, first served). Once capacity is reached, parents are welcome to volunteer but may be required to pay the student rate. Please ensure that all paperwork is completed prior to departure. Volunteers **must** have a Criminal Record Check and have completed all volunteer forms on-line. Volunteer forms can be found at www.sd43.bc.ca/maillard by clicking on "Parent eForms". Volunteers will need to bring a lunch and to dress appropriately. Thank you for your assistance.

Complete form and payment in full: allows students to reserve a spot in their chosen activities. Students will be required to meet supervisors to check in at designated times and are expected to arrive promptly, ready to proceed.
