ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

To be eligible, the applicant must:

- 1. BE A CURRENT GRADE 12 STUDENT AT CABE (OR GOAL) OR HAVE GRADUATED CABE (OR GOAL) WITHIN THE LAST 18 MONTHS**

For example, if you graduated June 2023, you must apply by the November 2024 deadline for consideration in December 2024. Students who have attended CABE (or GOAL) for at least 75% of high school or for at least 12 months, but are graduating from another school are also eligible to apply.

- 2. DEMONSTRATE ACADEMIC SUCCESS SUFFICIENT TO ENTER POST-SECONDARY**
- 3. PROVIDE WRITTEN CONFIRMATION OF ENROLMENT AT A PUBLICLY FUNDED POST-SECONDARY INSTITUTION AND STUDENT NUMBER**
- 4. REGISTER FOR DESIGNATED POST-SECONDARY STUDIES WITHIN 12 MONTHS OF RECEIVING THE SCHOLARSHIP AWARD NOTICE**

For example, if you are awarded a scholarship in June 2023, you must register by June 30, 2024 to start classes at a post-secondary institution in September 2024. Failure to meet this requirement will result in your scholarship being revoked;

- 5. SUBMIT PROOF OF COMPLETION AND A WRITTEN REPORT UPON COMPLETION OF THE APPLICABLE TERM OF STUDIES**
- 6. SUBMIT A COMPLETED AND SIGNED WAIVER AND PHOTOGRAPHY RELEASE (ENCLOSED) WITH YOUR SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION SUBMISSION**

Only one scholarship will be awarded per student.

APPLICATION PROCESS

Applications are reviewed by a volunteer selection committee and approved by Wesbild Holdings Ltd. and the Port Coquitlam Foundation.
