Gaming grant plus parent donations for next year: Money available next year before fundraising:

- 1. Spending revised downward by \$3700 from numbers presented in May due to events not happening because of COVID-19.
- 2. Motion to approve spending up to \$4000 on bulk purchase of school supplies for the 2020/2021 school year. The funds would come out of this year's budget. This does not have to continue for future years.
- 3. Note about the grade 5s. For the past several years, the PAC has paid for the bus for the grade 5s to go the waterslides. This year, because the kids can't go, we are paying for the yearbooks. The total was \$460, but there was money leftover from the hoodies earlier in the year. There may still be some costs paid by the PAC a small gift or treat for each grade 5.
- 4. Gaming grant is not certain for next year. We receive \$20/student each year. That money can only be spent for extra-curricular activities. We generally use it for rollerblading, hip hop, field trips, etc. If we don't receive that money, and we are still able to do the extra-curricular activities, then we can decide next year how to proceed. We always have the option to ask parents to pay for the activities, instead of the PAC covering it.
