There really is never a dull moment around Birchland. Last Friday the children were thrilled as we opened our new forest play area. As you will probably remember this playground is the result of a 'School Community Connections Grant' that we



received. This grant comes out of a one-time \$10 million dollar investment by the Provincial Government in 2005. The grant is managed by the union of BC municipalities and the BC School Trustees Association. The district crews started their work by leveling the ground



and removing a few of the smaller trees that were in the area. Unfortunately this work took a little longer than we had hoped due to the amount of rain we encountered this spring. After the site was prepared, several large rocks were brought



in and placed in both a large circle and path through the play area. The crews also took several large logs, flattened the top of them and used them to add to the rock path. The crews then down put landscaping fabric in the anticipation of the arrival of 135 yards of woods chips! Finally crews moved the wood chips



into place and we were able to open the playground! Unfortunately the first day we opened it, students were able to play for about 15 minutes before their play was interrupted by the presence of a bear on the playground! Finally, today,

students were able to spend their entire recess and lunch in the new area! Over the past week our students have also been thrilled to start using much of the new playground equipment that was purchased with the "Be There For Schools" grant. It has also been great to have the students from Mrs. Odberg's class taking responsibility for our new equipment. Moving it out before recess and lunch and then ensuring it all comes back in at the end of each break!


