### **Student Safety and Supervision**



The district wide expectation is that at dismissal time students will be picked up by their caregiver. Students who are walking home need to do so right after the dismissal bell. Please keep in mind that we will provide supervision for students waiting to be picked up at the end of the day until **2:40pm.** At that time, an announcement will be made to ask students who are still waiting to return to the office where we will help them to contact their parent or caregiver. We are asking that you follow the Provincial Health Office recommendations and take your child(ren) directly home at dismissal time. Feel

free to come back to the playground after 3:30pm when it is less crowded. We want to ensure all the procedures and protocols we follow at school have a positive impact and consequently we need those protocols to be consistent after school as well. We thank you for cooperating with this system, which is designed to make sure that students stay safe and healthy.

Thank you to those drivers who have been following the drive through regulations and obeying the signage on Bramble Lane. A reminder that the drive through is just that -a drive through. Drivers need to always remain in their cars. Emergency vehicles need to be able to access the drive through at all times. If you want to meet your child(ren) at their classroom door, please park on the street or the tennis courts.

Our Kindergarten Registration opened January 27<sup>th</sup> and ends on February 4<sup>th</sup>. Children who are five years old on or before December 31, 2021 may enter school in September 2021.
