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## GRADUATION INFORMATION

Grade 12s are expected to attend a very important assembly on **Wednesday, October 10<sup>th</sup>**. They can attend in either Period 3 (if they don't have a class) or immediately after school. They will receive information about transcripts, post-secondary, Commencement, Grad Dinner/Dance, AfterGrad valedictorians, etc. Grade 12s should also see our Accounting Clerk, Ms. Leung, in the office asap to order their cap and gown for graduation. They will need to know their height, with shoes. They can pay the \$65 for this event in a lump sum or see their Vice Principal about a payment plan. The commencement fee covers the cap, gown, 2019 grad tassel, commencement programs, and the use of the Orpheum Theatre.

## TAKE YOUR KIDS TO WORK DAY

All Grade 9s are to accompany their parent or guardian to work on **Wednesday, November 14**. If a parent or guardian cannot take their Grade 9 student to work, the student can go to work with a relative or family friend. This program is entering its 24<sup>th</sup> year and is part of the Learning Partnership program. Current research shows that adolescents will likely have a variety of jobs in their lifetime, and that will require the acquisition of new technologies and skills. The Take Your Kids to Work Day motivates, inspires and encourages our Grade 9s to think about their career possibilities after secondary school.
