The Summer Child & Youth Pass returns this summer! Here's the scoop—the pass is only **\$20** (taxes included) and is valid from June 17 to Sept. 5. It's available for children **0** – **18** years old for unlimited access to Coquitlam's drop-in activities, including Indoor and outdoor pools; Drop-in sports, including basketball, badminton and volleyball; Drop-in skating; and <u>Fitness centre and drop-in fitness classes</u> (available only to youth 13 – 18 years old).
