<u>CARE Project</u> - Our CARE project supports up to 50 families with weekly groceries. We are looking for volunteers to help us sort and pack these groceries on Wednesday afternoons (~12-3pm) for 7 weeks starting on July 6th. This would be at our office in Port Coquitlam.
