<u>Horatio Alger Vocational & Technical Education Scholarships 25 \$3,000 Scholarships funded through the generosity of the Members of the Horatio Alger Association of Canada</u>

To be eligible for the Horatio Alger Vocational and Technical Education Scholarship Program, an applicant must:

Have completed high school (or earned high school equivalency credential) by July 1

- Be enrolled in a 3 years or less career or technical degree/certificate program at a not-for-profit institution in Fall 2024 that will lead to employment
- Demonstrated critical financial need (\$65,000 or less annual net income per family is required)
- Demonstrated perseverance in overcoming adversity
- Be under the age of 35
- Be a Canadian citizen

Apply from March 15 until June 15.
