GRADE 11 INTERNATIONAL APPLICANTS FOR UBC, FALL 2020

CHANGES TO UBC'S ENGLISH LANGUAGE ADMISSION STANDARD

For the 2020 Admission cycle, students will now need to demonstrate four or more years of recognized, full time education in English within Canada in order to meet UBC's English Language of Admission Standard. Previously the minimum years of study was three years. If you are working with students who will only have three years or less, they can still meet the ELAS requirement by achieving the competence standard indicated by one of the tests of English language proficiency that evaluates skills in listening, reading, speaking, and writing.
