The boys came to play in the second half though and were able to capitalize on a Nathan Kokuryo free kick in which Roman Bandiera was robbed on the goal line, but Nico Porretti cleaned up the rebound to tie the game. With 5 minutes left in the game and Best still controlling most of the possession, the Centaurs mounted a counter attack and leading scorer - Dante Bandiera - was able able to slide a shot past the goalie to give the Centaurs the lead.

Adalberto Zavala was brilliant in net, while Porretti, Kokuryo, Couper Saunders, and Christo Angelis were outstanding on defence. Dante Bandiera was dominant in the middle of the park, while Jee-Oh Lee and Diego Rangel provided some creativity in the attack. The team now plays Port Moody on Thursday and will put their 5-1 record on the line against the Blues. The game is at 3:30 pm at Trasolini Turf in Port Moody.
