SCHOOL PHOTOS

Grade 9 Photo Day, Thursday, August 31st

As part of the Grade 9 Welcoming Orientation on Thursday, August 31^{st,} those in attendance had their school photos taken by Artona photo company.

**Note: If your child is not able to attend the orientation, they will have the opportunity to have their photo taken with the rest of the student body on Friday, September 8th.

Grade 10's-12's Photo Day, Friday, September 8th.

All students, regardless of grade, must have their photo taken even if they choose not to purchase photos. Individual student photos are needed for the yearbook, student ID cards and the school data base. As photos are used for identification purposes, students are to be reminded that hats, props, masks are not to be worn. Those choosing to wear a mask will be asked to remove the mask the moment the photographer is ready to take the picture. Students will be brought down to the small gym by Leadership students when it is their turn to have their photo taken.

BRING YOUR OWN DEVICE

Dr. Charles Best Secondary is a Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) school and many of our classrooms use laptops on a regular basis. If your student does not have a device, we have a laptop loaner program operated through our school library. Students requiring a loaner laptop can come to the main office to receive a form to apply for a temporary device. Recommended Laptop Specs include:

- A minimum of 13-inch screen
- A full-sized keyboard
- Touch screens are not necessary.
- Hard Drive of 256GB or more
- Ram of 8GB or more

SCHOOL LOCKERS

On the first day of school, in Advisories,

- All grade 9s and 10s will be assigned a locker
- Grade 11's and 12's will be offered a locker from within a limited bank close to their advisory classroom.
- Students who miss this initial locker assignment should visit the main office to obtain a locker.
- Students are responsible for the locker they are assigned all year and will return the lock to the main office in June.

More details will be available on Sept 5th in Advisory.

REPORTING AN ABSENCE

Parents, if you child is not able to attend school on the first day, please contact the office by phone or email the school office at charlesbestattendance@sd43.bc.ca. It is important to know if your child will be attending Dr. Charles Best Secondary and will be returning on a certain date. For any absences throughout the year please use the same email above. It can be found on our school website home page under quick links "Absence Report."

DROP OFF/PICK UP

We have an extended day schedule. We have a few classes that start at 7 am and we have a few classes that start at 3:20 pm but most of our students attend between 8:16 am and 3:13 pm. Please know that students are expected to be in their classrooms by 8:16 or if they start in Period 2 then 9:40 am so they should arrive at school with enough time to get organized and get to class by these times. We have two main areas: the front of the school and the upper parking lot. Please understand that our drop-off and pick up areas get VERY congested so please plan for the extra time and we ask that you are patient, kind and careful. If your schedule allows, you might consider dropping your child off a little earlier than the rush and picking up a little later than the rush and maybe we can spread out the congestion.

Please know that you **cannot** pick up or drop off at the roundabout at the west side of our lot, staff lot on the west end by the bus parking cage, or down by the portables – it is dangerous and causes traffic issues. Please help us as we try to maintain a safe and efficient lot for your children and our staff.

VERIFICATION FORM/EMERGENCY RELEASE FORM UPDATES FOR 2023-2024

As our district continues to move towards digitization of student forms to ensure the confidentiality of personal information, Student Verification forms will no longer be printed and distributed to students during their first day of school advisories. Rather, starting this school year student verification forms will be published to the Family Portal for parents to access. An email will be sent to all parents during the 2nd week of September that will provide details of this new process.

DISTRICT EMERGENCY PROCEDURE INFORMATION

Next week during your child's advisory they will receive a "Student Emergency Release Form". For the safety of your child, it is important that you fill out the form and have your child return to the main office in the bin under their alpha last name; A-G, H-O, M-Z by September 15th.


