We are proud to announce that our school's swimming team had an amazing Provincial Championships in Nanaimo over the weekend.

Congratulations to the following swimmers: Lee P., Macey L., Ean V., Evan V., and Shayda T. Lee P. participated in three events, winning a silver medal in a close race in the 50m freestyle. He also finished 4th in the 100m freestyle and 6th in the 50m butterfly, beating his personal best time. Macey L. and Evan V. won silver medals in the 100m Breaststroke event. Ean V. achieved a personal best by finishing his B final in 1:06 (9<sup>th</sup> place). Shayda T., finished in 16th place in the 200m Individual Medley.
