The intent of the Uggla Family Scholarship is to promote equity and remove historical and existing discrimination, including barriers to full participation in social, cultural, economic, and political life. PATHWAY TO TEACHER EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP

The Pathway to Teacher Education scholarship (\$5,000) is awarded to 20 outstanding high school graduates who have demonstrated a commitment to and aptitude for a career in K–12 teaching.
