DEADLINE TODAY - EA TEEN ANIMATION PROGRAM

In this 15-week program, students learn the methods, techniques, and technologies used in animation and have the rare opportunity to learn from experienced industry professionals and hear from guest EA lecturers who provide project mentorship and skill development. If you are 15-19 and have a passion for animation and a talent for storytelling, this 15-weeks program (Jan 9 – May 14, running Tuesday nights) is an opportunity to grow as an artist and to develop a strong portfolio for post-secondary application.
