SCHOLARSHIP/AWARD INFORMATION

DAVID EVANS ARTS & DESIGN SCHOLARSHIP

The New Art Foundation of Vancouver is offering a **NEW scholarship**, open to everyone age 14-25 who is passionate about the arts and any creative endeavors (i.e. Visual Arts, Photography, Design, Digital Arts, Craftmanship). Talented students will have access to a comprehensive package of financial support, mentorship, exhibition opportunities, gallery representation, and career guidance and launch their career in the Vancouver creative community. **Deadline is January 19, 2024.** Learn more here.

UGGLA FAMILY BURSARY FOR SFU

Ten scholarships are awarded each year to students who face significant financial barriers to participation in post-secondary education. This may include students who identify as Indigenous, Black, or a person of colour, students living with disabilities, LGBTQIA2S+ students, and students of all gender identities. The Uggla Family Scholarship will provide funding for all tuition and fees, books, on-campus housing and meal plan, etc.

TCF REFUGEE AWARDS

There are four different Refugee Awards, each valued at \$3,000. By submitting only one application, students will be considered for all four. Each of the refugee awards is awarded to a refugee who has shown courage and determination while adapting to a new language and new culture in Canada. Must have studied English as an additional language sometime since arriving in Canada. **Deadline is January 31, 2024.** More here.
