YOUNG WOMEN IN PUBLIC SAFETY - SUMMER EMPLOYMENT

Grade 11 students identifying as female could have the chance to explore careers in public safety and security, connect with experts in the field, and visit public safety departments to experience daily operations. Examples are Canada Border Services Agency, Canadian Security Intelligence Service, Correctional Services, and the RCMP. The program is running July 8-12, 2024, salary is \$16.84/hour. <u>Apply here</u> by February 27.

POST SECONDARY EVENTS

UNIVERSITY OF VICTORIA - APPLICATION DEADLINES EXTENDED

UVic is still accepting undergraduate applications for September 2024 for most programs. Students should check <u>EducationPlannerBC</u> to see if their program is still open. They are encouraged to apply as soon as possible as applications can close without notice. Applicants with an admission average above 90% will be eligible to receive a UVic Entrance Scholarship valued between \$2,000 and \$4,000. International applicants applying from high schools in Canada with an admission average of 85% or higher are eligible for a University of Victoria International Entrance Scholarship valued at \$10,000.

TRINITY WESTERN UNIVERSITY

We'll be hosting a TWU recruiter in the foyer on **Tuesday, February 20th,** after school. Applications for their programs are still open and students are encouraged to stop by with any questions. Trinity's most popular programs are probably Nursing and Kinesiology, but there are <u>many other options</u> for you to explore.
