

## **Assignment #2 – Digital Footprint**

The goal of this assignment is for you to reflect on your digital footprint. There are three parts to this assignment. The first part of this assignment is to research what a digital footprint is and how your digital footprint can impact your future education, grad school application, or job and career prospects. The second part of this assignment is to create a digital project which summarizes what you found during your research by answer a few key questions. The last part of this assignment is to put your digital project on your Edublog and to assess it.
