**Requirements:** The BC Ministry of Education requires students to complete a **MINIMUM of 80** credits (each course has a 4 credit value unless otherwise specified). **Four courses (16 credits) must be completed at the grade 12 level (which includes English 12).** Most students graduate with more than 80 credits. One course designated **Applied Design, Skills & Technology (ADST)** or **Arts Education (AE)** must also be taken at the grade 10, 11 or 12 level.
