2013-2014 Citadel Club Day Information

Parents/Guardians,

We are once again excited to have our Citadel Club Day. This year it will be taking place on **Friday, February 28th, 2014.** Students will have a variety of choices for clubs. The club day schedule is the same as the regular school schedule, except for the Ski and Snowboard club. The Ski & Snowboard club must arrive at school at 5:40 am. The buses will be leaving at 6:00 am.

Like last year, we will be having students register online through the school website (secured site) which will require your son/daughter to sign in with their username/password. Students will choose their first choice as well as 3 alternate choices. If clubs are oversubscribed, then some students will be placed in one of their alternate choices. The online registration process will begin Wednesday, October 30th at 7pm.

We do require the support of many parents to make our club day successful. This includes driving students to/from the variety of locations where the clubs take place, and supervising groups of students. If you are able to support us by driving or supervising, please indicate that on the permission form when payment is made (if applicable) of the particular club your son/daughter is in. This form will come at a later time once students have signed up. Club leaders will then contact you with specific information at a later date.

The registration process is as follows:

- 1. All students <u>must</u> go online to complete the registration process:
 - a. Go to Citadel Middle School's public website (<u>http://www.sd43.bc.ca/middle/citadel/Pages/default.aspx</u>)
 - b. Click on Intranet (will require student username/password). Click on "Collaboration", then "Student Groups", finally "Club Day"
 - c. Click "Sign Up" and complete the process.
 - ** Students register for their 1st Choice, plus <u>3 Alternate Choices</u> (even if in Ski & Snowboard Club).

- 2. Register online for this club on Wednesday, October (see steps above). Registration for this club will be on a first come, first serve basis.
- 3. To complete their registration, starting on Wednesday, Oct. 30 at 8 am, students must hand in the <u>Ski & Snowboard waiver, information forms and money</u> to Mr. Shong (either before school, nutrition break, lunch, or after school ~ not during class time).
- 4. Due to the requirement of filling buses to capacity, Mr. Shong will number forms indicating place. If busses are not filled, depending on numbers of students in the club, students may be placed in an alternate activity (minimum 45 to a bus).
