- Adopt the Agenda Dese and seconded by Erika. All in favour. Passed.

Presentation by Mr. Gill – Steam innovations

- Working on Design Thinking with students (from Stanford University developed in 1996).
- One example of an upcoming project is the classic "egg drop" class using technologymicrochips parts and sensors.
- Tools to be used in class:
 - Cutting station (cutting mats and utility knives)
 - Laser cutter connects to laptop or on paper to create designs
 - Cardboard tool wall "using Make do" creations
 - Ring light and acoustic tiles which has created a podcast area
 - Lego wall
 - Using materials such as fabric, balsa wood (laser printing), cardboard, Keva Planks
- Who benefits? Gifted kids, students who need a different way to experience their classes, average students (makes weaker lesson more exciting).

Principal's Report: Tricia Tipper

- Her style for providing information at PAC meetings is fairly relaxed.

- She retired from principal role in 2017; has four children that have gone through the school system; has come back into principal roles over the years as needed.
- Looking to get a few parent volunteers for earthquake preparedness team, family affordability committee (district funding allotment) look for request in upcoming messages from office.
- Request for wish list for teachers due in by end of November to best use the gaming grant monies for the school year. Clarified with PAC that Gaming grant money (Wish list) is separate from the class funding monies that are being raised via family donations through the KEV account. Aim is \$200 per class division.
- Question to Mrs. Tipper is school a scent aware school? District is scent aware but not scent free. Request will go out to staff to be mindful of scents they're wearing in the school.
