Please use your [School Cash Online](#) account to reserve your seats at one of our two concerts, though there is, of course, no charge to attend the concert. Note that on the item page there is an error saying the afternoon show is at 2:30. The afternoon concert is at **1:30 pm**

As a reminder:

- There are two concerts, one at **1:30** in the afternoon and another at **6:30** in the evening.
- Each family may order two 'tickets'* for the spring concert, either:
 - 2 tickets for the 1:30 matinee **OR**
 - 2 tickets for the 6:30 evening concert **OR**
 - 1 ticket for the 1:30 and 1 ticket for the 6:30
- If you have more than one child in the school, please order your tickets through your eldest child's class
- We ask and encourage attendance at the 1:30 concert if at all possible as the evening concert has higher demand. We can only have **300** audience members at either concert so please be understanding of our space limitations.
- If your child(ren) are unable to attend the evening concert, please let their teacher know.
- Parking for the evening performance only, will be available on the back field. On-street parking is also available. The staff parking lot is reserved for staff only for both concerts. More information will follow next week

**note - while you are ordering 'tickets' online - you will not require a paper ticket to enter - we will have a list at the door.*
