Parent Information Evening Next Wednesday

The evening will begin with a presentation to all parents and caregivers from me of key staff members, during which we will share some overall initiatives of the coming school year, ways to best support your student, and other things to expect as we set off on an exciting new year.

School Cash Online Forms Coming

In the coming week or so, you will begin to receive notification about forms that need to be completed via your <u>School Cash Online</u> account. If you are new to Coquitlam River, you will shortly receive a separate email with instructions on how to set up your account. This is also how we will collect school fees for the bulk purchase of school supplies, field trips, and special projects, as well as complete permission forms, etc. Please ensure you keep your account up to date.



Traffic Procedures

It's that time of year when I remind us all about our parking...and *no parking*...rules at Coquitlam River. Ahh, who am I kidding? I'll be reminding us *a lot!* Who knows - maybe this will be the year we'll all just agree to abide by our pick-up and drop-off procedures! Here goes:

- The roundabout loops at the front and back of the school are for quick drop off and pick up *only*. Call is *kiss-and-go* if you'd like. If you're planning to pull into the traffic loop for pickup at the end of the day, please tell your child(ren) to be waiting for you in the traffic loop so they can quickly get in the car and you can clear the loop for the parent waiting to come in.
- Do not leave your car parked in the traffic loop to walk into the school grounds.
- If you are walking your children to the door, or waiting with them until the bell, you must park on Shaughnessy and walk into the school grounds.
- Do not park in the staff parking lot. Our school staff has increased this year and we have a limited number of spaces available. The parking lot adjacent to the school is reserved for school district staff only.

Following these few simple protocols will allow for the safe, efficient movement of students and traffic as they enter and exit the property. Your cooperation is much appreciated.

BC Demographics Survey

We all deserve to live in a province where we have equitable opportunities to thrive. But many of the systems and structures our society is built on turn a blind eye to the unique needs of Indigenous Peoples and racialized people. That's why the B.C. government is running two important initiatives. They're asking everyone in B.C. to fill out the BC Demographic Survey to help identify and eliminate systemic racism from government programs and services. The survey is available online in 15 languages until Oct. 15 and will take about 15 minutes of your time. It is available at https://antiracism.gov.bc.ca/bcdemographicsurvey

The B.C. government is also asking for public input in developing anti-racism legislation that will hold government accountable for addressing systemic racism within its programs and services, and to provide supports to those who have been negatively impacted. No matter what your experiences or background is – your input matters! The public questionnaire is available until Oct. 15 in 15 languages and takes about 10 minutes to complete.
