November is National Family Literacy Month and this year we will be hosting Club R.E.D (Read Each Day) during this month. We hope students "FALL" in love with reading! Ideally, students will Read Each Day, but we realize life gets busy and some days there just isn't time or it just doesn't work. Therefore, students can miss up to 5 days during the whole month and still become a CLUB RED member! Each Club Red member will get a leaf to add to our Family Tree. So, CRE please help fill our tree full of leaves.

Here's how Club Red works:

Primaries- Read 10-15 minutes each day in one of the following ways:

- Read aloud to someone
- Take turns reading with someone

Read to your child/ listen to reading

Intermediates- Read 20-30 minutes each day

- Independently
- Listen to reading (podcasts, audio books) •

This is a daily reading assignment. We need to remember our new motto: The More We Read the Better **Readers We'll Become!**

Please use the calendar below. Each day, please supervise your child colouring in one section on their FALL in love with reading calendar (The first space November 1st, etc.) You should initial each day to verify the reading.

By signing only on the days your child reads at home, you are showing your support for the importance of reading at home each day. Put the calendar in a visible place for the month, like the fridge OR in your child's planner. Have your child return their coloured calendars to their teachers by December 6th, 2023.
