Technology at Eagle Ridge – Rick Botero Digital Literacy Teacher

Rick discussed what is funded and not funded by district:

Funded:

- Wifi
- Cables
- Teacher Laptops
- Printers (only 1 color printer per school) ;
- Photocopier
- Mobile Lab (our school is lucky enough to have a computer lab still)

Not Funded:

- Other student laptops
- Rick to teach digital literacy to Grades 2 – 5
- Ipads for K-2 and special needs learners
- 60 ipads that we have at our school but still need more.
- Pilot program – 20 ipads
- Accessories – Our school is lucky to have accessories for coding such as Microbits, Spheros and Makey Make
- Projectors and Mounting – Mounting is easier for teachers and safer for students.

Rick also discussed the Laptop replacement project :

- 4 in each intermediate class
- They are currently 6 yrs old and needs to be replaced
- 10 laptops to be replaced this year for \$700 each.
