

NO IN-SCHOOL CLASSES ON APR 26 AND APR 27

On April 26 and 27 classes will not be running as scheduled. Students in Grades 10 and 12 (plus a few pre-arranged grade 11s) will be completing their required Numeracy and Literacy Assessments.

All other students will be working from home on April 26th and April 27th. Classroom teachers will inform students of what they should be working on over these two days.

(Please remember that other schools are in session and students are not allowed to visit other school sites during the school day. Thank you.)

ABOUT THE NUMERACY AND LITERACY ASSESSMENTS...

As part of the Ministry of Education's graduation requirement, students need to complete Numeracy and Literacy Assessments.

Literacy 10, Numeracy 10, and Literacy 12 Assessments will be taking place on Tuesday, April 26 and Wednesday, April 27. Students will be notified in various ways regarding the date, time, and location of each assessment. Students who are currently taking a year 10 or year 12 English class or a year 10 Math class will be notified by their current classroom teacher. Students who are not currently enrolled in one of those classes will be notified by email and Microsoft Teams. In addition, complete information for all students will be posted in the foyer starting on April 19th.
