Jennifer is the liaison person for Gleneagle. She wants to know if there is anything that parents are wanting to see happen at Gleneagle. She encourages parents to get in touch with the Minister of Education, Rob Flemming. Gaming funds do not reflect the true population of the school if the international students are taken into consideration. Jennifer explained that the international students do generate funds to the district as a whole helping in areas such as funding for special programs and hiring additional staffing.

District has a number of apprenticeship programs. The province will fund students up to one year after graduation for some of these programs.
