BCRPVPA BURSARY / SCHOLARSHIPS

- A letter of reference from a community organization that addresses your involvement with it.
- A copy of your interim high school transcript that includes all your Grade 12 marks to date.

Application Deadline:

All completed applications must be <u>postmarked on or before March 31st</u> of the year in which you will register in your program of studies. Faxed submissions are not permitted.
