### Customized Learning (CL) Instructional Time

SOME COMMON UNDERSTANDINGS FOR STUDENTS

- CL is classroom instructional time
- Students MUST BE in a current teacher's classroom.
- Students MUST arrive on time and stay in a classroom for the full CL period.
- When the "LIBRARY FULL" sign is out, please respect it and go to a classroom. Students MUST BE working on school work or silent reading.
- During CL time the MPR will be an available learning space for a designated grade. This designation will rotate each week allowing each grade level an opportunity to work individually or in small groups on classroom learning activities. For the first 2 weeks of semester 2 the MPR is available only to grade 12 students. After that, it will be on a one week rotation for each grade.

**Registration for AP Exams will be February 20-March 8 (8:00am-3:00pm) – no late registrations will be accepted! Please see the TALON Talks and the Gleneagle My School Day App under the “AP Exam” Channel for more information.**

- 1) Each exam will cost \$150.00 and there are no refunds if students choose to not take the exam.
- 2) AP exams which will take place Monday May 6 to Friday May 17. Go to <https://apcentral.collegeboard.org/courses/exam-dates-and-fees> for a schedule of the exams.
- 3) Students must register with Mrs. Chan in the office and can pay by cash or cheque only (cheques payable to Gleneagle Secondary). Note, SD43 Students not enrolled at Gleneagle must pay by cash, no cheques accepted. Only SD43 students can write AP Exams at Gleneagle Secondary.
- 4) Pre-registration Information booklets on the AP exams will be available upon registration.
- 5) Pre-registration meetings are mandatory and dates will be provided at multiple times, with notice prior to the exams. Any students wanting to take language exam MUST attend the online pre-registration session to set up their online exam (only one session will be offered for language exam pre-registration with notice).
