- 2) AP exams which will take place Monday, May 6 to Friday, May 17. Go to <https://apcentral.collegeboard.org/courses/exam-dates-and-fees> for a schedule of the exams.
- 3) Students must register with Mrs. Chan in the office and can pay by cash or cheque only (cheques payable to Gleneagle Secondary). Note, SD43 Students not enrolled at Gleneagle must pay by cash, no cheques accepted. Only SD43 students can write AP Exams at Gleneagle Secondary.
- 4) Pre-registration Information booklets on the AP exams will be available upon registration.
- 5) Pre-registration meetings are mandatory and dates will be provided at multiple times, with notice prior to the exams. Any students wanting to take language exam **MUST** attend the online pre-registration session to set up their online exam (only one session will be offered for language exam pre-registration with notice).
