### Registration for the Numeracy Assessment and English 12 Exam

Students registered in any Math 11 course this semester will automatically be registered for the Numeracy Assessment on January 23<sup>rd</sup>. Students registered in English 12 or Communications 12 will automatically be registered for the English 12 Exam on January 24<sup>th</sup> or the Communications 12 Exam on January 25<sup>th</sup>.

Manual registration is required if you are:

- a Grade 11 student who is not taking a Math 11 course this year at Gleneagle
- a Grade 12 student who has never taken the Numeracy Assessment
- a Grade 12 student who wrote the Numeracy Assessment last year and wishes to re-write
- a Grade 12 student who would like to re-write the English 12 or Comm. 12 exam
- a grade 12 student who is registered in English 12 or Comm. 12 in another school and needs to write the exam (student must show evidence of completion by the registration deadline)

### \*Numeracy Assessment

Students who need to manually register for the Numeracy Assessment, English 12 or Communications 12 must do so by November 20<sup>th</sup>. The registration link is available via the APP or on posters posted around the school. All students who are currently enrolled at Gleneagle in any Math 11 course, English 12, or Communications 12 course DO NOT need to manually register.
