CAREER RESOURCE

Attention all grade 12 students

who are applying to a post-secondary institution for next year! Here are two very important pieces of information:

1. If you have not already gone to the Student Transcript Service to select the institutions you are applying to, you need to get moving on this as quickly as possible. Some institutions have ongoing admissions and have already filled many seats.
2. Even if you have self-reported your grades or sent a pdf of your transcript, you are not finished! You MUST still complete the process on the Student Transcript Service by selecting each institution and making the request to have your official transcript sent to them electronically. This is true even if you have already been accepted—ALL post-secondary institutions will require your official transcript with your final grades sent directly by STS.
