7. District PAC (DPAC) Report – Darin Wong

- o PAC 101 end of September 2023
 - DPAC vs. BCCPAC: DPAC (district) is associated to the BCCPAC (provincial)
 - Gaming Account: Provided the required executives on the PAC are filled, we are given a gaming grant based on # of students in the school. There are restrictions as to how gaming grants are used. Can't hold the funds in the account for more than 3 years.
 - Fundraisers related to games/chance require a license.
 - Tax receipt min. is \$20 and is given by the school/district as requested by the donor.

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- Transition to the new reporting framework for children in Middle School letter grade system to proficiency scale. Change in reporting framework has come from the Ministry of Education's direction.
- If a child is given insufficient evidence on their report (i.e. significant length of illness leading to inability to issue a rating), parents are to be notified in advance before issuing of the report.
- <u>NaloxHome</u> is a non-profit group that is raising awareness to G8+ children on harm reduction and how to administer Naloxone (medication used to reverse effects of opiods). If the public administers Naloxone to someone who is overdosing – The Good Samaritan Act protects them from being charged for death.
