

## Heritage Woods Secondary Awards

### 1. Curricular Awards

#### a) School Based

- Honour Roll (3.25 GPA minimum, based on all courses except CAPP)
- Honours with Distinction (4.0 GPA)
- Super G (“G” in every class, on every report i.e. based on teacher comments)
- Department awards
  - Each course is to recognize their **Top Student** for the year. If there are a few students who come really close to being the Top Student, then teachers may decide to give an **Outstanding Student** award or two. In addition, the Music department (and perhaps other skills-based areas) will recognize Most Improved students.
  - In addition, teachers recognize students who have worked extremely hard, but are not top academic students, or students who have shown outstanding improvement in a skill area. These **Teacher’s Pride** awards are given out in class at the end of the semester.

- **Senior Athletes awards**
  - Grade 11 or 12 students who have participated in two or more school teams
