



### Scholarship Alert for Grade 11 students!!!

The Horatio Alger Association of Canada, the nation's largest provider of need-based scholarships, announced the opening of its undergraduate scholarship application process on December 1. Students currently in grade 11 who will begin their university studies in the fall of 2023 are invited to submit their applications.

A total of 170 need-based scholarships will be awarded:

- 160 Horatio Alger Canadian Scholarships, valued at \$5,000 each, to high school students in every province and territory with plans to attend university, and;
