



June is Indigenous History Month and Pride Month - a time to celebrate the history, diversity, and contributions of Canadians who identify as Indigenous or as members of the LGBTQIA2S+ community.


Pride Month dates back to demonstrations in 1970 in New York City, and has evolved into a month of festivals and celebrations across the world to celebrate the rights of people to be who they are.

June was declared National Indigenous History Month by the Government of Canada in 2009 in a unanimous decision. It was established to recognize the First Nation, Inuit and Métis people who have helped shape Canadian history, as well as celebrate their culture and heritage.
