Within 8 hours, teams will develop digital ideas aimed toward helping assist struggles with mental health and build awareness in societies today.




XdHacks Mini Vancouver will provide resources like workshops, keynote presentations, interactive activities and mentors to help better equip you with skills to create innovative designs.
