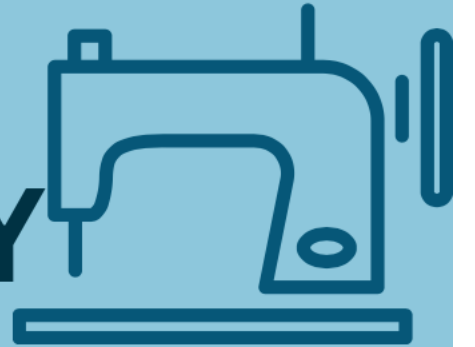

Eligible applicants must:

- Be a resident of BC
- Have lived in Canada for a minimum of 7 years
- Plan to graduate from a BC secondary school
- Plan to attend and study full time at a post secondary university or college
- Be ineligible for the BC Tuition Waiver Program (for former youth in care)
- Have experienced adversity or hardship
- Have exhibited a good work ethic
- Have demonstrated financial need
- Evidence of leadership involvement

Eligibility Criteria: (priority to those who meet all criteria)

- Academic Excellence
- Outstanding community, business or entrepreneurial leadership
- Financial Need
- Canadian Citizen, Permanent Resident
- Intending to begin University Study in September 2024
- Enroll at a partner university in a STEM field

1. Hand in an Unofficial Transcript from the BC Ministry of Education site.

2. **Write a 1 page; double spaced, 12 font size, single sided paragraph** stating why you meet the criteria for this award and why you should be selected.
3. Include a **Heritage Woods Financial Need Form**.
4. Provide a **reference letter** from a community member (not a teacher or staff member from Heritage Woods Secondary School).
5. Provide the **name** of 1 Heritage Woods Teacher/Staff Member who has agreed to be a reference for you. _____

Apply to be nominated for the BC Excellence Scholarship

There are 55 BC Excellence Scholarships available to recognize well-rounded B.C. graduates. Winners demonstrate service and leadership, both at school and in their communities. Winners also show aptitude and commitment to their chosen career paths. They will receive a \$5,000 scholarship voucher to use towards their post-secondary tuition.

- You **must be nominated by your secondary school** in order to apply for this scholarship. Only one student from each school may be nominated. Deadline for nomination application January 17, 2024, 12:30 pm

- **Application for nomination:**
- You must submit everything required for the online application (resume using the online template, two reference letters, written statement using online template) PLUS a copy of your most recent transcript from Student Transcript Service. **DO NOT** complete the BC Excellence Nomination Form - only the one selected student will complete that form.

- Students selected as conditional recipients of the BC Excellence scholarship must meet the following requirements **by August 31 of their graduating year** to be confirmed as a recipient and receive their scholarship voucher:

- [meet basic eligibility requirements](#);
- be eligible for a B.C. Certificate of Graduation (Dogwood Diploma);
- fulfill the requirements of the B.C. Graduation Program;
- be graduating in the same year the scholarship is awarded; and
- have the following final marks.
 - Minimum “B” average in grades 11 and 12 courses required for graduation.
 - Minimum "B" (73% or above) in Language Arts 12.
 - Minimum “B” average, no more than one "C+" (67% or above), and no marks lower than “C+” in courses that fulfill graduation requirements for Science 11 or 12, Math 11, and Social Studies 11 or 12.

Reminder: ONE STUDENT may be nominated from Heritage Woods but only 55 students in BC are selected as winners.
