





AP Psychology 12

- We will be offering *AP Psychology 12* **next year!**
- This course is available to Grade 11 and 12 students (priority will be given to Grade 12s). It is a more rigorous version of Psychology 12 (description is in the course booklet). Writing the optional exam can result in first-year University credit.
